1 GET A COPY OF YOUR RAP SHEET

You can pick up your RAP sheet in person at the SFPD Identification Bureau, Hall of Justice, 850 Bryant Street, Room 475, 4th Floor, SF.

If you would like to obtain a copy of your rap sheet by mail, if you need a fee waiver or if you have other questions, stop by a walk-in clinic or contact us.

2 FILL OUT AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION

You can get an application at a walk-in clinic, online, or by contacting us.

Once we receive your application, we will review your eligibility and contact you with further information.
